INGHAM COUNTY TRAIL AND PARK MILLAGE FUNDING AWARDED TO SIX LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS

INGHAM COUNTY – Ingham County is pleased to announce that Resolution #17-109 was passed by the Ingham County Board of Commissioners on March 28, 2017 awarding funding to six local municipalities for trail improvements. The trail and park millage approved by voters in November 2014 generates approximately \$3.4 million in revenue annually. Resolution #17-109 provides \$2,990,895 for several projects. The approved projects provide for new construction, trail repairs, support for a Volunteer Coordinator position and development of a trail plan.
